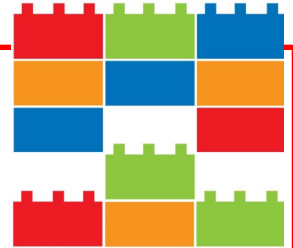


DEADLINE: October 30

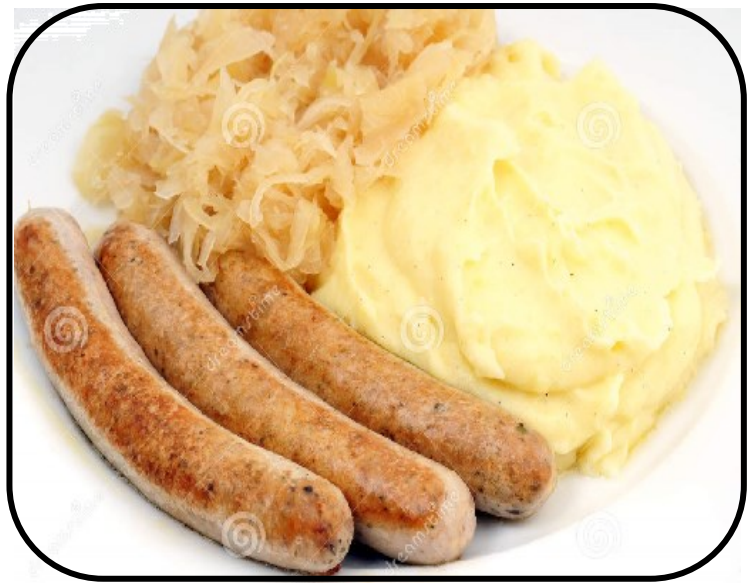
