Dear Friends,

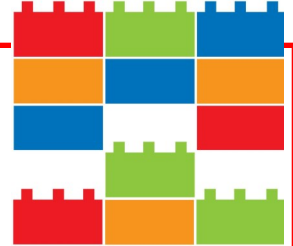

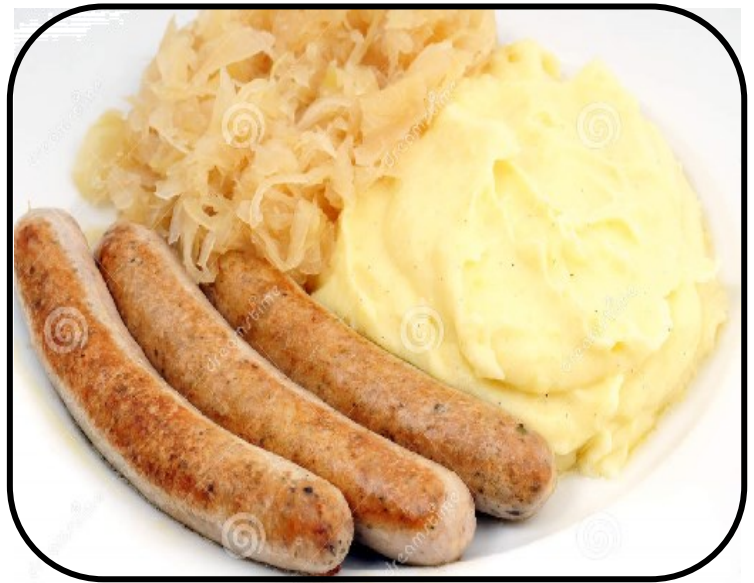
